

Clifton Beach Wind Farm - Media Release/Public Statement.

The proprietors of Cape Bouvard Pty Ltd have instructed the company to withdraw its application to establish a wind farm on its 5 Lake Clifton properties having a combined land area of almost 1000 hectares. This will now to be sold as one or individually.

The reason for this decision is because CBI representatives reported that during the open days there was great concern amongst the Lake Clifton Community, in the belief that turbines would destroy the tranquillity of residents living close to the site. And, hostile claims that property values would be affected were expressed. Though this is based mainly on perception it has been taken most seriously resulting in the project's termination.

It was reported that many of the community were looking forward to a peaceful retirement in the area and as the proprietors and their family have enjoyed the Peel region for over 30 yrs they do not wish to risk destroying this for others whether perceived or not.
